

GENERAL RULES FOR CLOSING DAY EVENTS

TROPHIES

All Trophies should be brought to the September CRYA meeting or to DYC by 0900 on the Saturday of Closing Day weekend. Clubs not returning Trophies will incur a 10 point deduction and engraving will become their responsibility.

CANNON FIRING

Cannon firing will be judged by the criteria of (1) Safety; (2) Presentation (includes formation) (3) Clean up; (4) Uniforms; (5) Etiquette.

If the wadding from your shot goes over the bank, you will be disqualified.

HORSESHOES

National Horseshoe Pitchers' Association of American Official Rules are used. A copy should be available on Closing Day for reference if needed.

LINE TOSS

Best of TWO throws on the centerline.

Deviation to side of centerline is subtracted from overall length of throw.

DINGHY PARADE

Up to 20 feet in length or a total of 20 feet if using more than one dinghy.

Dinghy must contain all required safety equipment (cushions are no longer Coast Guard approved).

Extra points are given if Daughter of Neptune is on board.

Judged on criteria of (1) theme; (2) creativity; (3) safety

HOR D'OEUVRES

Judged on the criteria of (1) Taste; (2) Creativity; to be chosen by each club (3) Appearance & Presentation
